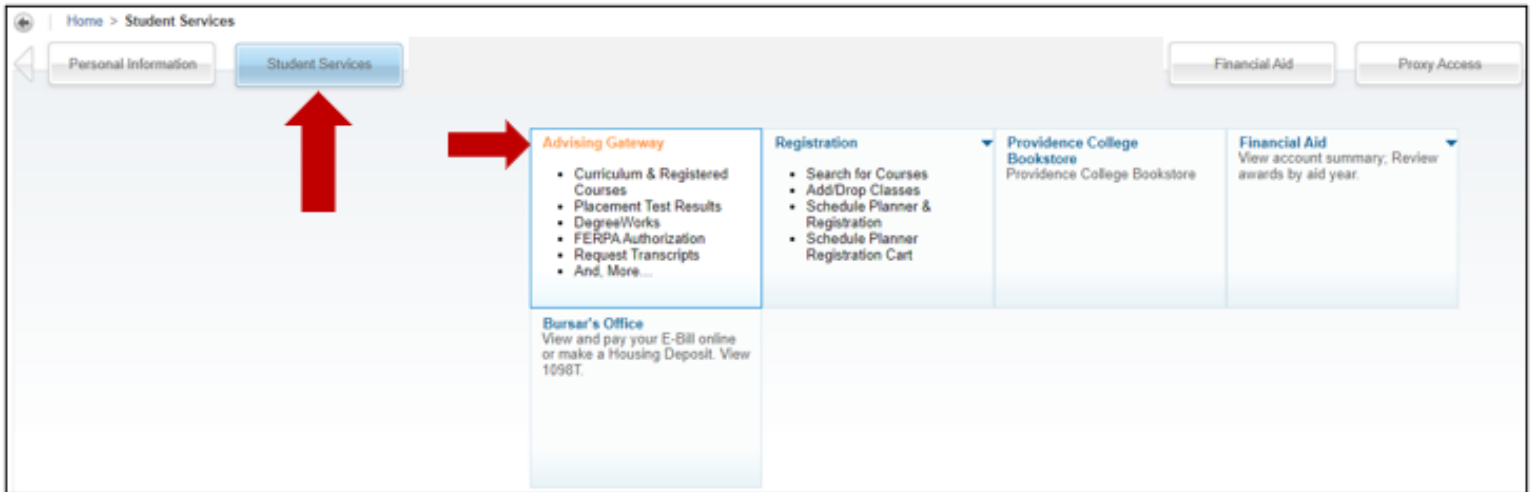


## How to Prepare for Registration

### 1. CyberFriar (using Network Credentials) - Student Services – Advising Gateway




2. **The Advising Gateway** will display placement test results, curriculum and registered courses, degree works, view midterm grades, your advisor, and hold information. We recommend using *DegreeWorks Degree Audit* to determine what your next semester courses could be.

4. **DegreeWork Degree Audit:** The Degree Audit is comprised of user-friendly sections.

5. The **Student Information** section offers a snapshot of relevant facts including student level, program, major(s) or minor(s), academic standing, class year, and advisor(s). You will also see the following when it is relevant: PC Scholarship (scholarships that require specific academic standards), student-athlete status, and/or international student status. Below is an example of a double major. If the majors fall under two separate degrees, you will use the degree drop-down menu.



6. The top right section of an audit displays a printer, envelope, and three vertical dots. These icons allow you to **print the audit**, **email your advisee**, or **view class history**.





## How to Prepare for Registration

7. The **Student Information** section also allows you to view degree progress by completion percentage - accounting for met requirements, credits, and cumulative GPA. Additionally, you can view in-progress classes or pre-registered classes. The degree audit updates nightly. Use the **PROCESS** to view any changes since the last nightly update.
